



The Birth Of Prophet Eesa (Jesus)


PEACE BE UPON HIM

Maryam submitted to the will and decree of Allah. Jibreel breathed into the sleeves of her garment. She conceived Eesa, and she withdrew with him to a far place (Bethlehem valley)




The pains of childbirth drove her to the trunk of a date palm. She shook the trunk of the date palm, and fresh ripe dates fell upon her




Allah provided Maryam with water and food and commanded her not to speak to anyone (Maryam 19:24-26)
